<b>Over-Production</b>		
1	<p><i>Making or processing more than is necessary or making things faster than is necessary</i></p> <p><i>Completing unnecessary forms, having to involve people that don't contribute.</i></p>	
<b>Transportation</b>		
2	<p><i>Unnecessary handoffs, transfers, distances of material &amp; information.</i></p> <p><i>Sending forms to clients to sign or requesting information from 3rd parties.</i></p>	
<b>Inventories</b>		
3	<p><i>Information or things e.g. customers or forms waiting in a queue</i></p> <p><i>Backlog of customers waiting for service. Excess stock in store rooms that is not being used (could be paper forms)</i></p>	
<b>Motion</b>		
4	<p><i>Unnecessary people movements and journeys, travel, walking, searching</i></p> <p><i>Visits for which the information could have been collected earlier or in a different way, staff going to different offices</i></p>	
<b>Producing Defective Products/Correction</b>		
5	<p><i>Rework, work done because of errors in a previous process</i></p> <p><i>Re-doing assessments because correct information was not provided in the first place.</i></p>	
<b>Over-Processing</b>		
6	<p><i>Redundant or unnecessary processing. Things we do that don't add any value but add cost.</i></p> <p><i>Answering phone to other staff asking for results</i></p>	
<b>Waiting</b>		
7	<p><i>People waiting for things or information to arrive. Information waiting on people to arrive.</i></p> <p><i>Waiting for a result from a different service (e.g. Health) before you can continue.</i></p>	
<b>Under utilized human potential</b>		
8	<p><i>Not making the best use of the people involved</i></p> <p><i>Not providing the business tools needed to perform and continuously improve each employee's assigned work</i></p>
